A-101

- Students must take honors / AP courses in the subject they are identified in to remain on active status in the Cumberland County AIG program.
- Students must also maintain a B / 80 in that course.
- Provide academic advisement for the student if their grade falls below the 80 threshold.
- Make sure AIG students' curriculum stays on a rigorous pathway while in high school.
- I will screen all 9th grade English honors students for possible placements.
- 9th - Provide students with arts and science enrichment this year.
- 10th-12th – Students will attend university tours and meet with admissions counselors. Some colleges include UNC, NC State, ECU, UNC-W, Methodist, FSU, UNC-P, Campbell.
- My advice to students for high school - make sure you get involved, this looks great on college and scholarship applications, plus you will make new friends and have a sense of belonging and ownership in your school.
- ...AND keep your grades up!
